Chthonius kewi



C. kewi is uniform yellow-brown with faintly reddish pedipalps and chelicerae. Distribution: Europe: found only in Britain were it was thought to be restricted to the East (Essex, Norfolk, Suffolk, Kent) coast and only found amongst decaying drift-line debris and large pebbles on the upper-shore/splash zone. The species has also been recorded from the coast of Dorset. Records from inland include Lincolnshire, Norfolk, Sussex and Nottinghamshire. Length of body: 1. 4-1. 8mm.
