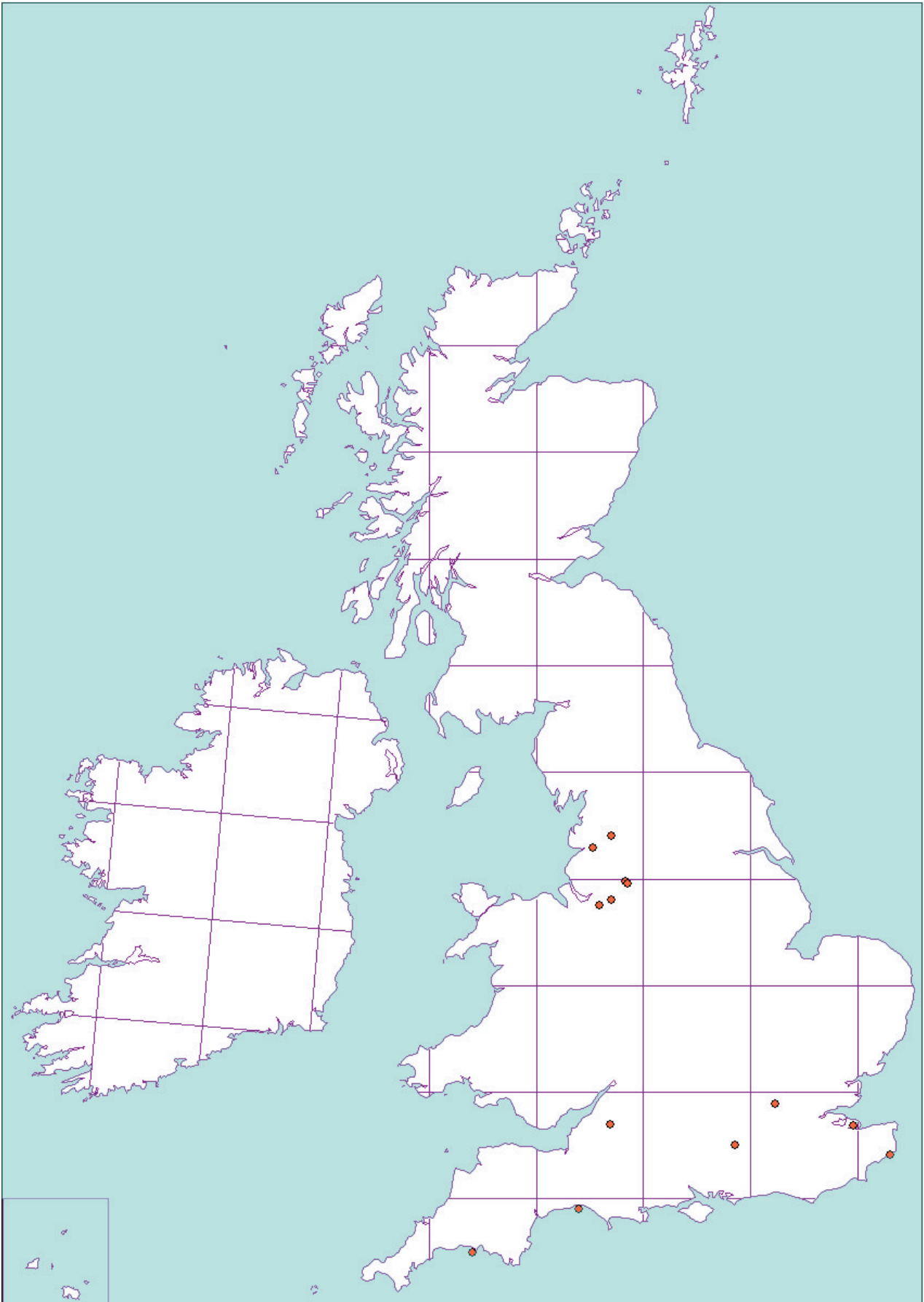


Withius piger



Withius piger has a cephalothorax that is reddish, pale-brown; the opisthosomal tergites pale brown with small darker patches, and pedipalps clear reddish-brown. It is associated with stored food products (especially grain) and warehouse debris and being synanthropic it has probably been introduced into Britain in ship's cargos. In 2006 a female was found in a farm barley store just south of Bristol Body length: 2. 3-3. 0mm.
